



# 21 DAYS TO PRAY

## NOVEMBER 1 -21, 2017

For 21 days, join a united prayer season as the church leans into our relationship with the Lord. We strongly urge spouses to pray with one another or to join with a prayer partner. The guide on the back of this page is designed to be a help, but not in any way to limit what the Spirit may lead you to pray about.

We suggest setting a specific time and place for praying together daily. Read the passages aloud together and pray in response to what the Lord calls to your attention. You'll note that we have given a broad direction for something to look for; again, this is just a guide, not something to hinder God's voice as He speaks through His Word and His Spirit.

### Considerations for prayer time

- Prayer is our relationship connection to worship, praise, thank, God: Matthew 6:9-13, 33, Psalm 42:1-2
- Independent time with the Lord is important preparation for corporate prayer: Psalm 139
- Spouse or prayer pairs: Matthew 18:20, Genesis 2:24
  - As spouse praying together, consider how these topics are carried out openly, honestly and lovingly in the ministry the Lord gave you to one another, your family and the world around you.
  - While praying with a partner in Trinity or externally, consider God's work in your lives through these topics.
- Allow the Lord to direct your time with Him and each other: Psalm 46:10-11
- Pray continually: 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, Ephesians 6:18, Philippians 4:6
- God's Word provides direction for prayer (read more scripture for context if needed) : Deuteronomy 6:1-9, Psalm 119:105, John 17:17, 2 Timothy 3:16-17, Romans 12:2, Colossians 3:16
- Prayer is our connection for an effective Christian life (God's effectiveness): Nehemiah 1-2:10, James 5:13-18
